- Travel restrictions, retrieving employees

Building inspection:

- 360° photo cameras
- Camera headsets through Microsoft Teams

Commissioning

- Example: Bosch Rexroth → fully remote
- Large projects: Relocate for commissioning
- Changed contracts, technical acceptance







DELIVERY IMPACT

Own keel delivery:

- Using local crew
- Problems with crewing
- Change to heavy lift

Heavy lift delivery:

- More reliable during covid-19 crisis
- Creative responses required for changing regulations
