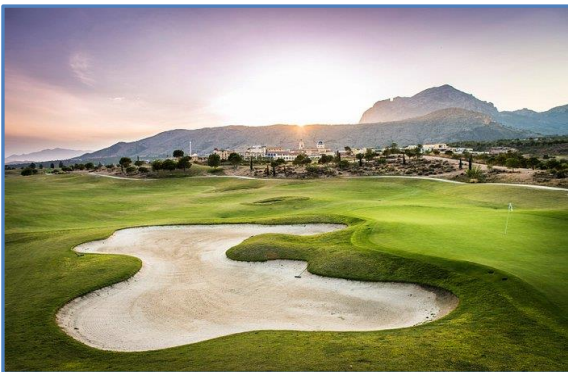
The venues for the ETA 60th Annual Meeting Benidorm (Alicante) 13-16 June 2023

Asia Gardens Hotel

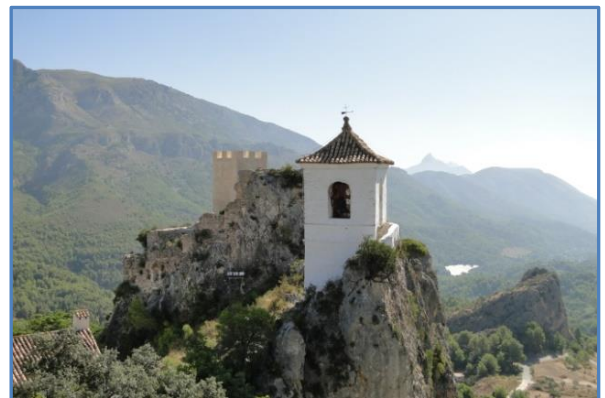
La Falúa Restaurant

Guadalest and its castle

Town of Altea

Altea is the most beautiful and the best preserved town in Costa Blanca. The old section is perched on top of a hill from with spectacular views. Its old quarter is full of charming viewing points and its picturesque pedestrian center keeps the

traditional character of a typical Spanish Mediterranean town, with whitewashed houses, lovely squares and the unmissable blue and white domed church on the top of the historical center.
